- I. Call to order & introductions. Dennis D, Steve T, Sheryl G, Kathleen G, Valerie V, Cyndi M, Tim A, Raul Z; guest Tim A.
- II. Treasurer's report (KG). Balance \$932.64. \$25 was spent to pay for ONDNA's portion of sponsoring City Council Debates. KG will investigate filing for nonprofit status for ONDNA.
- III. Webmaster's report (Joel). No report.
- IV. Old Business items
 - a. Vacant/neglected lot at 507 F (status of our blight complaint). DD submitted a blight report and heard from the city blight officer that she and the fire department were looking into it. If they deem there is a problem, in a few weeks after a letter is sent to the property owner the city may issue a citation for \$100, if then still nothing is done they can issue a second citation for \$100 and/or for \$200.
 - b. Fifth Street Reconfiguration project, B to L (status of city actions/inactions). ST reports on errors in data public works reported to city council for accidents on 5th street. From 1/03 thru 5/08 = 196 accidents btw B&L including 303 vehicles, 96 injuries, 25 pedestrians/bikes. ST will report next meeting if Public Works meets with him and/or gets a specific "study more" recommendation before the council.
 - c. Community Church Homeless Services (possible OND statement?). DD recommends we discuss this at our next meeting. DD provided documents illustrating a flurry of recent discussion between community members and churches and the city's housing-issues planner.

 - c. Outgoing OND Chair's thoughts on her two years and an even better future. SG suggested a need to make more orderly the list-serves. SG thought a personal highlight was the smooth work of the tree committee, using some OND expertise.
